

Guidance for Regional Clubs on Graduate Alumni Outreach March 2023

This builds on the foundational advice highlighted in the <u>January 2023 T-QUAD</u> on innovative ways to strengthen regional clubs through engagement with graduate alumni.

Why is graduate alumni outreach important?

Graduate alumni are over 30% of all alumni! In some regions, they are a much higher proportion. As noted in the presentation, "graduate alumni are key to maintaining the vibrancy and strength of our regional clubs."

What can regional leaders do?

- 1. *Recruit graduate alum talent to your board leadership*. Add an officer position specifically responsible for graduate alumni programming and outreach
- 2. Support virtual events by and for graduate alumni.
- 3. *Add a graduate alumni element to popular existing club events,* such as Annual Meetings and New Admit Receptions. Reach out to the APGA to learn more about successful graduate alumni events hosted by other regional associations
- 4. *Send a warm and customized welcome to new grad alums in your region.* The APGA and Office of Alumni Engagement will coordinate and send the lists to you each year
- 5. *Use inclusive language*, e.g., use "graduate and undergraduate alumni" in place of "alumni"; when working with University organizations, ask them to include graduate students/alumni
- 6. *Use the #PrincetonStar hashtag** in your e-blasts and social media when you have news involving grad alums (for example, you might note that "#PrincetonStar Robert Kahn *64, who is often called the 'father of the Internet', received the 2023 Madison Medal on Alumni Day")
